Frequently Asked Questions

What is WCA?

As part of Perth Zoo's efforts to support the conservation of threatened species in the wild, Perth Zoo has launched a new wildlife conservation fundraising program. Money raised through WCA will support the conservation of threatened species in the wild.

WCA will support the conservation and research of native frog species threatened by the deadly Chytrid Fungus and some of the rarest and most endangered species on earth including Sumatran Orang-utans, Sumatran Elephants, Sumatran Tigers, Javan Gibbons, New Guinea Tree Kangaroos and African Painted Dogs.

What is workplace giving?

Workplace giving is a simple and effective way of making regular donations to a nominated fund that is entitled to receive tax deductible donations and is approved by your employer. You pledge a nominated amount (of your choice) and your donation is automatically deducted from your pay and forwarded to the nominated fund.

How workplace giving helps WCA

The workplace giving method is reliable and convenient. By providing ongoing donations, you will be supporting the future sustainability of key species in the wild.

As WCA is managed by Perth Zoo, there is no administration cost charged to the fund. That means 100% of your donation goes to where it is really needed.

What's in it for you?

Your employer has elected to deduct your workplace giving donations from your pre-tax employee earnings. By contributing to a pre-tax workplace giving program, you receive the benefit of an immediate tax deduction for your donation. Depending on the donation amount, the tax deducted from your regular pay may be reduced.

To put it into perspective, a donation of \$20 from pre-tax earnings (assuming a marginal tax rate of 30%) would only cost the donor \$14.

As an example:

	non donor	donor
Earning per fortnight	1346	1346
Donation	0	20
Taxable income	1346	1326
Tax deducted	-250	-244
Take home pay	1096	1082
Cost of Donation	0	14

This is an example only and does not take into account any individual circumstances of employees.

How will I know my donation is making a difference?

You can elect to receive updates on how WCA is supporting the conservation of priority species in the wild.

What happens at tax time?

Your employer is responsible for keeping a record of your donations each year and will provide you with a summary of your donations at the end of each financial year to record on your tax return.

Did you know...

- More than 1,500 Australian animals and plants are threatened with extinction.
- Two Australian frog species have already been lost to the deadly and highly contagious Chytrid Fungus and 52% of our remaining threatened frog species are infected with the disease.
- It is estimated that as few as 7,300 Sumatran Orang-utans are left in the wild.
- Three of eight tiger species became extinct in the 20th Century and there are now fewer than 500 Sumatran Tigers left in the wild.
- As few as 200 Tenkile (Scott's Tree Kangaroo) – found only in Papua New Guinea – remain in the wild.
- African Painted Dogs, once widespread across Africa, are now reduced to small, scattered populations totalling no more than 2500 individuals.

Every dollar helps:

- \$30** can buy a pair of boots for a member of an anti-poaching unit in Sumatra or Africa
- \$46** can feed one rescued orang-utan for one month
- \$70** can fund a wildlife village patrol in Papua New Guinea for a week
- \$100** can help purchase vital wildlife monitoring equipment
- \$200** can help buy an anti-snare and radio collar for an African Painted Dog
- \$300** can help fund critical research of native frog species threatened by the highly contagious Chytrid Fungus
- \$500** can build a research hut at a wildlife monitoring site in Papua New Guinea
