1. Read and sign "*Sender's Packaging and No Dangerous Goods Declaration*" on the Reply Paid Label.
 2. Complete Sender's Details Label, writing clearly in Block Letters.
 3. Cut out and fix the Reply Paid Label and the Sender's Details Label onto a sturdy bag with glue or sticky tape.
 4. Place up to 4 phones in the bag, seal it and post it at any Street Post Box or at any Australia Post Outlet.

Important Note:

We recycle mobile phones ONLY. Please DO NOT post batteries only, or any other waste. This costs ARP and therefore our affiliated charities. Thank you. Please use a strong and sturdy bag that cannot break open during postage.
